

Earl Fischer, 88, of Aurora: beloved husband of June for 64 years, father of Larry (Charlotte), grandfather of Laura and Alison, step-grandfather of Stephanie and Brad, great-grandfather of Kyra, Megan, Bradley, Kaily and Cody, and brother of Wilma Lazier. Preceded in death by sons Darrel and Terry.

Earl was born in Milford, Nebraska and grew up in the farming community. In 1940, Earl and June moved to Wichita, Kansas where he worked for Cessna Aircraft. After World War II, Earl and June moved to Denver in 1946. After short periods with the Rio Grande Railroad and Gates Rubber, Earl went to work for Monarch Airlines, which merged with Central Airlines to become Frontier Airlines. Earl retired from Frontier after 36 years of service.

Earl was active with son Larry and the Boy Scouts, enjoyed softball, bowling, traveling, fishing, hunting, antiques and gardening. He was a Trustee of the First United Methodist Church of Aurora. Earl became a University of Colorado football fan as son Terry's enthusiasm rubbed off on him. Earl never lost his loyalty and devotion to his home state of Nebraska, however, where his remains will be returned to the Milford cemetery.
