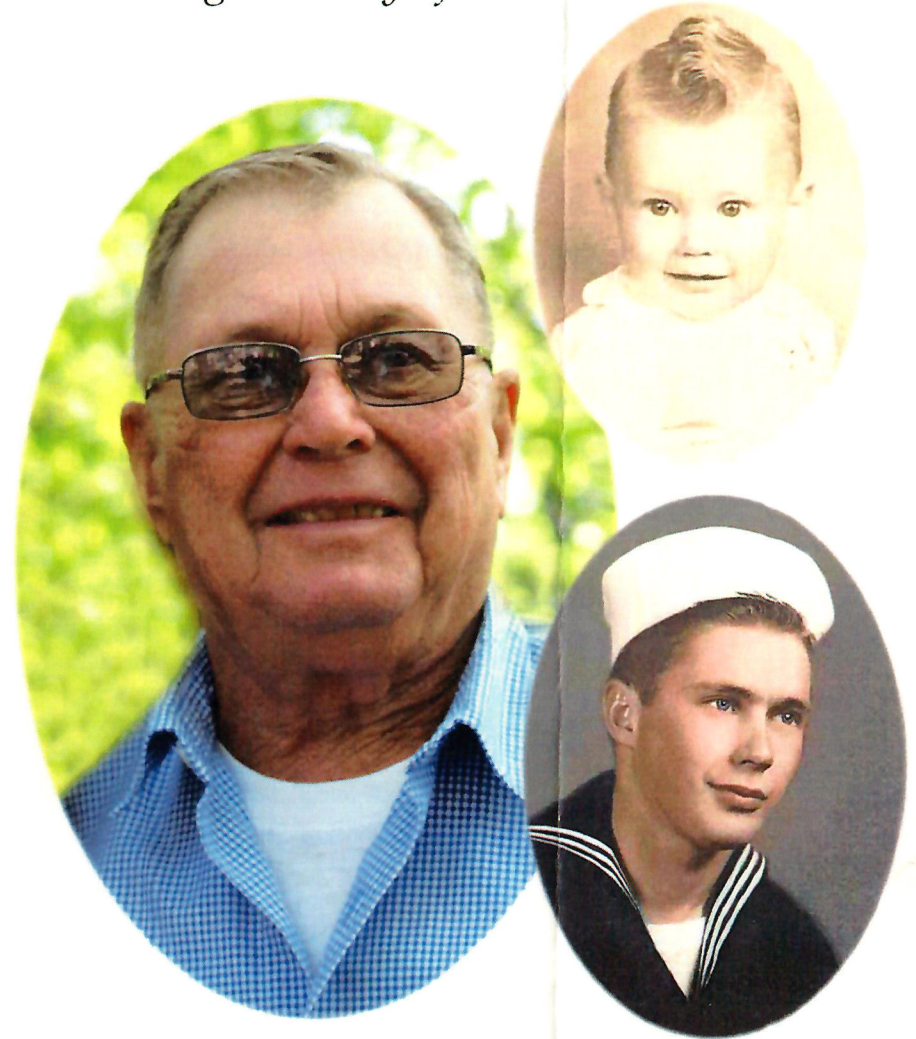

# Ed Callison
