

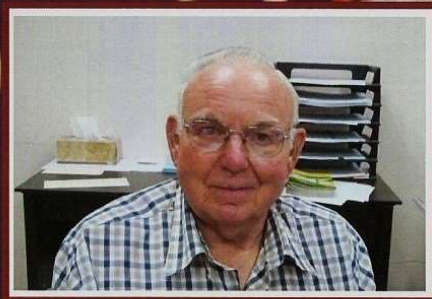

## OBITUARY

Elza R. Duckett passed away on Sunday, May 17th, 2020. Ray was born on December 8th, 1936 in Howard County, Arkansas, the son of the late Elza R. and Ula J. Littlefiled-Duckett.

Ray married Anne E. Donnelly-Duckett on April 11th, 1959 in Chicopee, MA. They had no children.

Ray joined the US Air Force in 1955 as Airman II. He then served with the New Mexico Air National Guard before moving to Tulsa with Anne and attending Spartan College Of Aeronautics Technology. Ray was employed with Central Airlines (Frontier Airlines) for over 20 years as a mechanic. He then worked through retirement with American Airlines in Tech Service beginning on his 50th birthday, he retired from AA on March 30th, 2002.

Ray and Anne liked to travel, were members of e Mazda Miata club and Tulsa Gun Club. Ray was an avid woodworker who loved building in his shop. He was a member of Central Baptist Church since 2001 where he worked with the children and youth ministries.
