

Frontier Magazine featured an article, "The Flight That Changed a Life," in its '75 spring issue about Skip Fletcher, a first officer for Frontier.

We will give a short resume of the article for the benefit of those of you who didn't read this issue.

Skip was raised in a show-biz family and received intense singing lessons from 1949 until 1953, at which time he joined the Army. During his Army days, he won the 3rd Army Singing Contest, appeared on the Arlene Francis network TV show, the Arthur Godfrey "Talent Scouts" show and others.

Skip learned to fly after leaving the Army; when he wasn't flying, he appeared at the "Italian Village," "Blue Mist," Jack Ruby's "Carrousel Club," "Club Vegas," and many other Dallas night clubs. He also was Staff Vocalist for Channel 8 WFAA-TV Dallas.

In 1965, Skip became a copilot for Central Airlines. (Central later merged with Frontier.) In Skip's words: "I was becoming disenchanted with night club singing, etc., and nothing seemed worthwhile except my flying career.

"In the summer of 1972, I was flying with Captain Bob Churchill and he gave me a copy of Hal Lindsey's best seller, THE LATE GREAT PLANET EARTH. After reading the book my lifestyle completely changed 10,000 feet over Fayetteville, Arkansas."

Skip gave up night club singing and now has a ministry in song when he's not flying.

Because of the article that appeared in Frontier Magazine, Mr. Cliff Barrows of the Billy Graham Crusades contacted Skip and he appeared on the Billy Graham Crusade in Lubbock, Texas, Friday, September 5, 1975.

Skip has been besieged by requests to appear throughout the country and has appeared on three national TV shows.
